Good Standing in the Medical Scientist Training Program Approved November 2, 2021

- 1. Students have read the MSTP training grant and brochures and agreed to abide by the regulations of both academic degree programs accepting full responsibility for the completion of dual degree requirements.
- 2. Students will act in accord with the ethical code promoted by the School of Medicine. Students will advance their ethical training through participation in the MSTP. Students are expected to be respectful in all interactions with program students, faculty and staff and must adhere to the SOM Code of Conduct.
- 3. Required Academic Performance: USMLE, medical school, graduate school, see linked material.
- 4. Students will procure commitment of support from a planned PhD mentor by end of MS2.
- 5. Promotion Committee Letter. Annually the MSTP Promotion Committee will review the student's performance in medical school, graduate school and MSTP. A summary of the committee's report will be posted in the student's profile on the MSTP website. If the committee identifies a student that lapses from Good Standing in the MSTP, the student will need to remediate per instructions while on probation or may be dismissed. This may or may not affect their standing in the individual degree programs.
